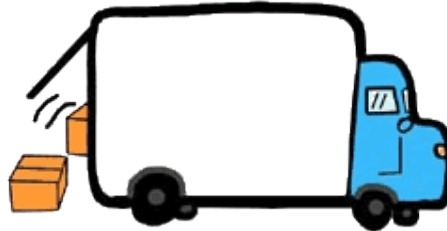

It has got me thinking about what I *really* need and how much more time I'd have for many more worthwhile things if I wasn't endlessly dealing with 'stuff'... buying it, disposing of it, dusting it. Even my 3-year-old daughter has started to 'get it' as she happens upon one of those post-Christmas charity ads on the telly calling on our help. While she can choose which dolly to play with or which twirly whirly skirt to wear she has begun to grasp that the little boy in Africa staring out of the TV screen barely has enough food or water, let alone toys or clothes or 'stuff'.

So as I start as your local Anglican priest here in Hurst Green I will pray every day that *my* life will be ruled by God and not other distractions. In God's strength, I will step into God's stream of love and care for this community, which has already been flowing for years. I will do my best to lead the congregations of both churches in faithfulness to God and with them I will make sure that every one of you feels welcomed. Please come into your local church any time bearing questions and burdens, or hopes and prayers and discover something of God's restorative presence in amongst it all.

## Have a banana

Fairtrade Fortnight is from 24 February - 9 March and bananas are an important part of this year's campaign. Foncho (or Albeiro Alfonso Cantillo) is coming from his home in Colombia to help with the campaign all over the country.

Bananas are big business in the UK, we eat an astonishing 5 billion a year, most of which are bought in supermarkets. There is a big opportunity for us all really to help poor farmers to get a fairer deal and a better life. Most banana farmers, whether they work for big plantations or on small family plots, live at near starvation levels of poverty. They are at the end of a long supply chain with prices being squeezed at every level, driven largely by the purchasing power of the big supermarkets.

Fairtrade changes all this. Whatever price the supermarket charges, the producer will be paid enough for sustainable production plus the fair-trade premium, which can be invested in the business or in community projects. Many Fairtrade growers work together in small co-operatives and use the premium for the community. For Foncho it has meant that he can afford for his teenage son and daughter to stay in education, his daughter is training to be an accountant.

Some of the supermarket chains are committed to Fairtrade. In Oxted the Co-op, Sainsbury's and Waitrose sell only Fairtrade bananas and Morrisons has a few. Bananas are something most of us buy regularly, it would make a big difference to Foncho and all those other farmers if we buy Fairtrade.

## Memories of the Mothers' Union

My first encounter with the Mothers' Union (MU) was in the 1920s when I was a schoolgirl living in Croydon. There was a meeting near West Croydon station for the railway workers' wives and I would go along to play the piano for the hymns.

My first real introduction was when my first child was born six years after we were married - the war intervened. We were living in Sanderstead and I felt there was something missing in my life so I asked the Vicar if there was something I could join. He suggested the Mothers' Union. This was something wonderful. We met in the church hall but nearby lived a lady in a large house who had retained the nanny who brought up all her children. They were happy to have all the children for the afternoon - heaven for all.

The Mothers' Union is like the British Legion in that if you are enrolled in one branch you can go anywhere in the world and be welcomed with open arms; I have experienced this welcome several times.

When we moved to Hurst Green Mrs Bickersteth was the Enrolling Member and also ran the Young Wives group. I was rather hurt when asked to leave the Young Wives and go up to the MU, but in due course this was very satisfactory and I took on various duties like booking speakers. The MU was a wonderful opportunity for non-working wives, as most of us were in those days, to get out and take part in activities away from babies-and-bacon. Each meeting consisted of a Bible reading, prayers, a talk by a visiting speaker followed by tea and cakes. Occasionally we visited other branches and there was an annual Garden Meeting. Once a year we took our banner to a service at the Cathedral, and there were occasional conferences at the Fairfield Halls. At one of these meetings a certain Bishop asked a lady in the audience why she belonged to the Mothers' Union. "Well sir," she replied "It's the only thing that keeps me from murdering my husband."

### OXTED & DISTRICT HISTORY SOCIETY

John Tolley, assisted by his son, Ian, gave a talk to the Society on 'An Enclosure of the Waste at Limpsfield'. Tenants of the Manor of Limpsfield traditionally enjoyed rights on the Waste or Common at Limpsfield. These rights enabled tenants to graze animals, collect wood, fodder and animal bedding and make ends meet. Without them, tenants could end up as paupers, a burden on the Parish ratepayers and even in the Limpsfield Workhouse. Their status was threatened when, due to the extravagance of Marmaduke Gresham, the assets of the Manor had to be sold off after his death in 1742 to pay his debts. The Limpsfield Commoners' rights were diluted as a result and their grievances aired at a meeting at 'The Bull'.

Although the Gresham fortunes were restored following the marriage of the Gresham heiress to William Leveson-Gower in 1804, the Commoners' rights were still under threat. At a meeting at the 'Lord Rodney' in 1846, 17 members of the Limpsfield minor gentry resolved to attempt to enclose Limpsfield Common. However the proposal failed and Limpsfield Common was eventually passed to the National Trust in 1972.

The Society meets on alternate Tuesday evenings in winter at the United Reformed Church, Oxted at 8pm. On 4 February Roger Packham will talk about 'The History of Cricket' and on 18 February Geoffrey Meade will tell us about 'Industrial Growth in Surrey'.

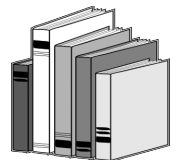

Lyn Ives, Manager at  
Oxted Library writes:

It is hard to think of any downsides to working in a library. We provide a huge range of services. The library is a popular meeting place for local people and visitors and has an excellent collection of books, DVDs, talking books and information. Computer users can either use the public internet PCs or log in with their own devices using our free wifi connection. For children there are regular Rhyme-times, Storytots and Storytime Club, there are author events for both children and adults and we support about 50 reading groups. Every summer we host the Summer Reading Challenge which was originally for children but has now been extended to include teens and adults.



Working with the public is certainly varied. It can be helping to find a book, helping with IT problems, showing someone how to search the catalogue on their own device, issuing a bus pass or checking a blue badge application form for a disabled driver. A typical day can include setting up the library, helping with self service, holding a junior event, running an IT class, hosting a school visit, making an outreach visit to a school or nursery, dealing with reservations and deliveries of books, and stock control work.



We want to be at the heart of the community and I truly believe we are. We are busier now than we have ever been and I hope we provide a warm and friendly environment for people from our whole area to visit. One of the joys of working with the public is to provide a service and the whole team get a lot of satisfaction with that. The library had been in Gresham Road for 40 years last year so we held a tea party to celebrate and look forward to more busy years.
