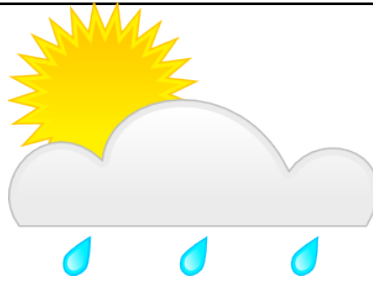
Sunshine after Rain, and a farewell to Hurst Green

If you would like to join us, please ring **Doug Parsons, Transport Manager**, on **722286** as we now have a few spaces on some of our routes.

We are also looking for volunteer drivers for the 12 seater minibus. Drivers need to have a Group D1 on their licence and be reasonably fit to help lift shopping trolleys off and on the bus. Full training will be given to suitable applicants. The usual rota is 4 hours once every 4 weeks. SPRING ...is now very much in evidence with daffodils and tree blossoms, camellias, azalias and magnolias showing their cheery colours - and in my case, a container grown Mimosa with its lovely yellow pom-pom tiny flowers.



Time now to keep weeds under control, even they have managed to survive the winter's continuous soaking! Chit potatoes are now ready to plant. Protect fruit blossom from late frosts. Tie in climbing and rambling roses and mulch well. Sow hardy annuals with bee and butterfly loving flowers such as zinnias, forget-me-nots, comfrey, catmint, clovers, lavender, honeysuckle and foxgloves. Sow spring bulbs now that the soil is beginning to dry out. I also increase watering of house plants which are now blooming well especially Amaryllis and colourful pelargoniums, of which I took cuttings and had blooming indoors over winter. Cut back summer flowering clematis to encourage strong growth. Lift and divide clumps of overgrown perennials.

Don't forget that if you're looking for inspiration, our speakers cover many interesting topics, so do come along on the second Wednesday of the month at St Agatha's Hall at 8pm and you will be made most welcome with refreshments in the interval to discuss any garden matters.

40th Anniversary of LINK

This year, Oxted & District LINK celebrates its 40th Anniversary when it holds its AGM at the York Rooms, St John's Church, Hurst Green, at 7.30pm on Wednesday, 30 April. LINK is a registered charity and provides a community service for those in the RH8 postal district who, for whatever reason, cannot use public transport. In 2011, LINK was proud to be awarded the Queen's Award for Voluntary Service, the equivalent of an MBE for an individual. LINK is largely funded by donations from those helped and advertising in the LINK Directory. Although LINK has around 150 volunteers, it is always on the lookout for more. If you are able to volunteer for a few hours a week or month, please phone **LINK on 713333**.

LINK telephone volunteers man the LINK phone line on 713333 from 9am to 5pm on weekdays and from 9am to 11am on Saturdays to receive requests for help. Telephone volunteers operate from their own homes on a rota of one day every 6 weeks and can claim telephone expenses. Driving volunteers use their cars to take RH8 residents, unable to access public transport, to medical and other appointments. Drivers work on rotas of a half day every 2 weeks to take people to local appointments or to East Surrey Hospital. Others do occasional drives further afield. A mileage allowance may be claimed by volunteers.

The LINK Porter Trust was set up with a legacy in 1992. It helps people in RH8 who are facing short-term problems/crises. The Trust received 29 applications in 2013 and spent over £6,000 in grants. Applications to the Trust need to be supported by a local organisation, aware of the applicants' circumstances e.g. CAB, Social Services, Health Visitors, local Councillors or a Church. Grants are made of goods and services, not cash, to help applicants 'back on track'. Long term debts are not usually considered. Application forms can be obtained from the Trust's Secretary, **Judy Bunn on 723370**.
