

## Every Part Counts

I have recently started having a jigsaw on the go although I admit to favouring 500 pieces over 1,000! As I completed my last one, a round one with irregular shaped pieces featuring Plants of the Hedgerow, I found myself reflecting on how vital each piece is to complete the whole picture. It is so frustrating when you find that one piece is missing! The apostle Paul in 1 Corinthians 12 speaks of the Body being made up of many parts, each as important as the others in making the body complete.



With the general election looming it is easy to feel that our vote is not important or that it will not make a difference. But in the grand scheme of things each vote is one piece needed to form the whole. We are presented with many debates and broadcasts and leaflets full of what they want to do to make our country a good place for all people in society to live. Each party is seeking our vote which reminds us that we live in a democracy and we are free to vote for whoever we want to in a free and fair election.

It is easily forgotten that this is a relatively recent privilege. Before 1832 only men who owned property above a certain value could vote. In 1872 secret ballots were introduced, but it wasn't until 1911 that all men over 21 could vote. Only in 1928 did all women get the vote. In 1969 all eligible people over 18 were given the vote. All of these changes only came about because people campaigned for them to give us the freedoms we have today.

We hear in the news of countries where people have to vote for a single candidate and yet in others where people queue for hours for the privilege to vote. In some countries people face active opposition or even risk their lives to place their vote. Even when the people have voted, we hear of voting boxes being tampered with and the vote becoming corrupted. When wondering whether or not to vote, we should remember the right to vote has come at a cost and should be considered a privilege.

This month we are bringing a summer opera gala to Hurst Green on the 30 May, with a programme of favourite opera pieces and popular songs. Featured are international tenor Richard Lloyd Owen, mezzo soprano Charlotte Tetley and soprano Sophie Pullen. Richard has sung all over the world having a busy schedule in over 80 concerts annually. Charlotte is a Samling Scholar and also has an active schedule. Sophie is a young upcoming soprano. ## Time Out...

Spring is here; we can shake off the winter lethargy and turn our thoughts to days out or country walks. Why not tell me some of your ideas for local days out? Please do send your favourites to the Compiler and share your ideas. One of my favourites is:

**CHARTWELL** - only 15 minutes drive from Hurst Green, although difficult to reach by public transport, Chartwell was the much loved home of Sir Winston Churchill for 40 years, apart from during WW II. He fell in love with the site and the setting and in 1922 bought the house without telling his wife; he suspected (rightly) that Clementine would disapprove. He then had the house extensively altered to suit his tastes.

There is so much for the visitor to see, from walks in the grounds and lovely gardens to the studio and the house itself. Children are well catered for, especially at holiday times. The Studio in a converted cottage in the grounds houses many of his paintings. The main house is utterly fascinating. When Sir Winston died Lady Churchill moved back to London but she had the house returned to how it was in its heyday in the 1920s and 30s. It retains its atmosphere of a happy family home, but filled with the legacy of Britain's great leader and the memoirs of his long and active life. Soldier, statesman, writer, painter - the memories are all here.

The Exhibition "Death of a Hero" which commemorates the 50th anniversary of his death has rightly been very popular and will continue throughout the season. The house is open every day from 11am to 5pm. It is free to National Trust members but otherwise costs £13 for adults or £6.50 for children; grounds and studio only are £6.25 or £3.10 for children.

East Surrey Museum is situated centrally in Caterham about 50 metres from the station. Established in 1980, it is run by a team of volunteers. We are a very friendly bunch and would love to see you here to enjoy the collection and possibly help us run it. We are proud to say that since 2009 we have been fully accredited by the Arts Council.

There is a very extensive collection covering all aspects of the surrounding area. This includes: a large number of early 20th century postcards with images of most local villages; an extensive collection of books, booklets, photos, notes and other information on local history; numerous large scale maps (25") covering most of East Surrey; many archaeological artefacts and geological specimens from the area.

Talks are given on subjects like local history, local geology, archaeology and WW2. These can be arranged for schools, local groups and care homes. Artefacts are available

## The Brigitte Trust - 30th Anniversary 2015

*Supporting people facing life threatening illness*

The Brigitte Trust is proud to be one of the adopted charities of Churches Together in Oxted and District for 2015. The Trust was set up thirty years ago by Brigitte Watkin who saw three friends die in hospital unsupported, when their wish was to end their lives at home. Brigitte founded a volunteer service, then named Hospice Home Care, offering respite to carers, emotional support for the whole family and the opportunity to share some of the emotional burden.

Today the service has spread beyond its Dorking base with just over 100 volunteers in place. In partnership with Macmillan Cancer Support the service has grown into East Surrey. Volunteers receive full training and support and commit 4 hours each week to visiting. Volunteers, who have full DBS clearance, visit the same client each week so a relationship is built up at this most sensitive time. Visits can consist of sitting with a family member whilst a carer takes a break, transport to hospital for treatment or to medical appointments, shopping, preparing a meal, picking up children from school or caring for children whilst a sick mother rests. Bereavement support for up to six months is also offered.

*"I truly felt that on the days my volunteer visited I could take a tiny step back and be myself, me, for an hour or two. This gave me a little bit of normality in what was a rollercoaster of a time. The support I received made me feel less isolated too."*

*"...the freedom to pop out, either to do some shopping or to meet up with a friend for coffee, knowing my husband was in safe hands."*

The Brigitte Trust is celebrating its 30th year in the community and is proud of its service and its volunteers. Training courses are taking place in Woking, Epsom and Crawley in the coming months and volunteers will visit locally after completing the course.

This summer will see displays on local Stone Age archaeology and early 20th century metal toys.

School holiday activities are run for children with their accompanying adults. These range from clay modelling to making cards and painting papier-mâché eggs.
