ALL CHANGE!

I recently read these familiar words which are to be found in Ecclesiastes 3: *A time for everything and a season for every activity under heaven.....* It made me reflect upon the changes we often face in our lives. I wonder how you deal with change?



I have to admit it always takes me a little time to adjust. Life ticks along and we get into a routine then suddenly it's all change; a new house, a new job, a new school, a new baby, a medical condition. My mother died recently and though it was very straightforward and peaceful, I miss her. There is no longer need for frequent trips to Salisbury, a new routine. I have had to adjust to a less mobile husband. We became grandparents a couple of years ago. Our son has gone abroad to study. Our routine changes.

On Sunday the children in Sunday school were thinking about the four fisherman called by Jesus to follow him. It struck me how at the moment they left their nets, lives changed big time!

When Elijah came to the farm and called Elisha to follow him, Elisha asked if he could go and say goodbye to his family. He killed and cooked his oxen and had a feast with his family and friends before setting out (1 Kings 19). His life took a new turn.

For many of us the changes in our lives may not be so dramatic. Perhaps your children have started at a new school, you have signed up for a new exercise class, your routine changes. At times when routine changes, when I adjust to changes in my life, I am comforted that 'Jesus is the same yesterday, today and forever'. God is immutable, He does not change, His love endures forever. He says to us 'I will never leave you or forsake you.'

My prayer is summed up in the words of a hymn written by Stuart Townend: 'You are my Anchor, My light and my salvation, You are my refuge, My heart will not fear.'

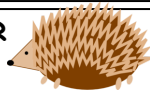

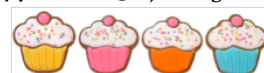
