Another November

Another November, another Remembrance Day. Time to honour those who died in the terrible conflicts of the two world wars and since, to give thanks for the peace and prosperity their suffering bought for us, and fervently hope that it will never happen again.

How did it ever come to this, that soldiers were mown down in their thousands in the First World War, and whole populations became the targets in the second? It is not as if nobody knew that war brought death and destruction, Armageddon was 3,500 years ago, the fate of the defeated city of Har Megiddo.

By the beginning of the 20th century the lesson had been forgotten; wars were mostly short affairs fought in far corners of the Empire. Winston Churchill, who was in the Army from 1894, wrote about his experiences in the Sudan campaign of 1898:

*This kind of war was full of fascinating thrills. It was not like the Great War (WWI). Nobody expected to be killed. Here and there in every regiment or battalion half a dozen, a score, at the worst thirty or forty, would pay the forfeit; but to the mass of those who took part in the little wars of Britain in those vanished light-hearted days, this was only a sporting element in a splendid game. Most of us were fated to see a war where the hazards were reversed, where death was the general expectation and severe wounds were counted as lucky escapes, where whole brigades were shorn away under the steel flail of artillery and machine guns, where the survivors of one tornado knew that they would certainly be consumed in the next or the next after that.**

Was it in the spirit of those vanished days that the Empires of the old Europe drifted in to World War I, forgetting the ravages wrought by modern weapons? The Second World War arose from the unsatisfactory treaties that ended the first, the weapons ever more chillingly efficient. Every November we come to remember the horrors of war, but we surely need to remember them every day of the year.

Guide Hut Renovation Appeal

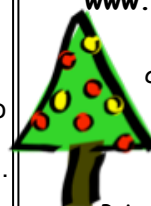
