April Fool

On the 1st April 1957 the BBC news programme *Panorama*, announced that thanks to a very mild winter and the virtual elimination of the dreaded spaghetti weevil, Swiss farmers were enjoying a bumper spaghetti crop. It accompanied this announcement with footage of Swiss peasants pulling strands of spaghetti down from trees.

Huge numbers of viewers were taken in. Many called the BBC wanting to know how they could grow their own spaghetti tree. To this the BBC diplomatically replied, 'Place a sprig of spaghetti in a tin of tomato sauce and hope for the best.' April Fool's Day is traditionally a day to laugh, and play jokes or hoaxes on other people such as in the story above. April Fool's day is first documented in this country in Chaucer's *Canterbury Tales* in 1392.

Well, just pray and ask God to show you if he's real. I'm fairly certain God will show up in your life if you ask him to, and if not then you can just call me a 'fool for Christ'!

HURST GREEN EVANGELICAL CHURCH



At the end of the 19th century Hurst Green was still a small village, but after the railway came it began to grow. St Agatha's opened in 1895; the Pains Hill Chapel, built in 1893, was the first local Evangelical Chapel. Hurst Green families would walk up to Pains Hill and often spend the day there, taking a picnic lunch. They would then walk home in the evening, in winter by lantern light.

In 1912 Evangelical worship in Hurst Green was strengthened by the arrival of Mr and Mrs Morphew. They began to hold services all over Hurst Green, in cottages, in tents and in the open air. A new evangelical

family, the Crittalls, moved into Mill Lane and started a Sunday School in their kitchen; soon the whole house was bursting at the seams with the growing congregation.

The pastor at Pains Hill, Mr Ryde, was asked to hold a Sunday Service somewhere in Hurst Green. Mr Blackman ran the Oxted Sanitary Laundry, situated where Hallsland Way is today. He was sympathetic to the Evangelicals and allowed Mr Ryde and a Mr Gurr to hold Sunday evening services in the laundry canteen. Children were not allowed to attend because of the hazards of stables, vans and water tanks at the laundry; they continued to meet at the Crittalls' until they moved in 1922.

Once more the laundry came to the rescue. Mr Blackman had built two rows of cottages for the laundry workers opposite the laundry; he rented the plot of land between the rows to Mr Ryde for 1 shilling (5p) a year. Mr Ryde erected an ex-army hut on the plot to be the new Evangelical Church. There was no gas, water or electricity, however the laundry kindly supplied buckets of hot soapy water for the church cleaners. The first service in the new hut was on 16 November 1922, although open air meetings were still held around the district.

By 1939 the church members wanted to build a more permanent chapel. To provide finance, outside support and Trustees the church joined with the Friends Evangelistic Band, and bought a piece of land at what is now Meldrum Close from Mr Blackman for £300. However, World War II intervened. After the war, the church continued to grow and appointed its first full time pastor, Stanley Edwards; the Edwards lived in a gypsy caravan while a Manse was built. By this time the ex-army hut also needed replacing, so the Meldrum Close land was sold to finance a new church building on the army hut site. Gifts from the local supporters funded a Baptistry and a new electric organ. The new chapel opened on 1 August 1955. It flourished from the beginning, holding 13 regular meetings weekly.

In 1966 the Edwards' retired and the chapel continued an active evangelical presence under a succession of devoted leaders. There was an emphasis on children and young people, with clubs and activities that many older Hurst Green residents still remember with affection. However by the end of 2003 age and illness took their toll and the pastors, Alan and Gill Bass resigned. The six remaining chapel members decided that they must keep the church afloat while they looked for a new pastor.

In 2006 Steven and Margaret Cox were appointed and have developed the work of the church ever since. The busy church holds three meetings every Sunday and it plays an active role in CTOD - Churches Together in Oxted and District. It continues to play a lively part in life in Hurst Green, in schools and old people's homes as well as providing the venue for the Busy Bees nursery.

GANG DAYS

Gang Days was the old Anglo-Saxon name for Rogationtide, the time when the whole parish went out into the fields to ask for a blessing on the crops which were vital for survival. Gang is the Saxon word for go or walk. There used to be several Gang Days in April and May; they were so important that King Alfred decreed that a theft committed on a Gang Day was as serious as one committed on a Sunday. Eventually the date for Rogationtide was settled on the 5th Sunday after Easter.

Throughout recorded history people have asked for blessings on the crops in the spring. The Romans had Robigalia, when they sacrificed a dog to the god Robigus to keep wheat rust at bay. The earliest Christian records date to the 7th century, when people would process around the parish and bless the fields with special services. The whole event became an excuse for a big party and by Elizabethan times bishops were urging their priests only to take the older and more pious men on the procession to avoid drunken revelry. Gang Days evolved into beating the bounds, when the men and boys went round the parish boundaries to learn the essential boundary markers. They beat the markers to memorise them and sometimes they beat the boys too. George Russell revived a "Beating the Bounds" walk here in Hurst Green; many parishes still have parish walks on Rogation Sunday.

Because Easter was early this year, Rogation Sunday is on 1 May. Hurst Green and Crowhurst were both very rural areas at least up to the 2nd World War. In the 1950s and '60s St John's used to process with the choir to Boulthurst Farm for a service. Rogation Sunday is also regarded as a time for giving as well as receiving bounty, so Christian Aid week often follows it, perhaps the last reminder of Gang Days.
