We will vote in a referendum on the Economic Union on 23 June to decide whether Britain stays in or comes out; the early rounds of football's Euro Cup get underway; and the Queen will officially celebrate her 90th Birthday over the weekend of 11 and 12 June.



It is interesting to me how all these events have 'sides' to them and yet from another perspective unite people too. The EU Referendum has clear stay and leave campaigns and yet both campaigns cross party lines - people who are usually quite distinct in their views find themselves coming together on one side or the other for this particular political debate. In any Euro or World Cup tournament, players who have previously competed against each other in different regional teams find that they, like their fans, now come together as the 'England Team'. And when there is any Royal Celebration there will be those who express their views for and against the Monarchy but will come together anyway as it is a good excuse for a party!

On that note, plans are coming along very well for the 'Party on the Green' for the Queen's 90th Birthday (12 June from 1pm on the Green near Aggies). The group organising this event have also come together from different perspectives but with a shared intention to celebrate our community here in Hurst Green. There will be a stage and a range of music: rock, jazz, folk, choral and a rousing Last Night of the Proms with the Oxted Band to end (at about 4pm). There will also be activities for children and birthday cakes to eat! The idea is that as much as possible is free. You are invited to bring a picnic (and chairs/rug) to simply relax with friends and family and enjoy the entertainment. We hope you can come!

But back to the previous point. In all our differences and diversity we must always hold on to that which we share. St Paul famously says in the bible that 'there is no Jew or Greek, male or female, slave or free because in Christ all are One'. Whatever our beliefs, opinions and perspectives, in our common humanity we are always more similar than we are different. Refreshments will be available from 11am with the service starting at 11.30am and lasting for about 45-50 minutes.

If you have children and want to try a relaxed service which feeds *your* soul as well as engages the children, then this is just for you! If you prefer a relaxed easy Sunday morning with a later start and a good cup of coffee, then this is just for you!
