THE HAYCUTTER

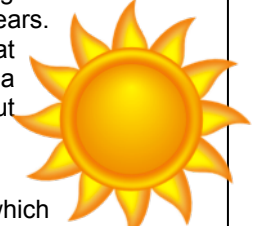

DOG DAYS

Dog Days are here again, supposedly the hottest and muggiest days of the year, when people who can take holidays and others swelter in the city heat.

Dog Days have a long history, feared for the disease and pestilence the heat brought with it. The Anglo-Saxon calendar defined them as 14 July to 5 September. The 1559 Book of Common Prayer says 6 July to 16 August, conveniently ending on St Roch's day, who was the patron saint of dogs. The name has conjured up lots of doggy references over the years. Brady's Clavis Calendaria of 1813 asserts that 'dogs grow mad' and Richard Harding Davis, in a book published in 1903, asked people to put out water for stray dogs.



But Dog Days have nothing to do with dogs. They mark the days after Sirius, the Dog Star, which is the brightest star in the constellation Canis Major, and the last star to appear before dawn. Sirius is Orion's hunting dog so he sits close to the Orion constellation.

The dates have changed over the years because of rotation in the earth's axis. In ancient Egypt they came in June, and marked the season of the life-giving Nile flood, and also marked the Egyptian New Year. In the ancient world it was thought that the star was so bright that it added to the sun's heat; the Greek poet Homer wrote 'Sirius rises late in the dark liquid sky on summer nights, bringing heat and fevers to suffering humanity.'

By Roman times the Dog Days had moved to August. Many Romans who could possibly afford it went on holiday to the Bay of Naples for August, a bad move in AD 79 when the disastrous eruption of Vesuvius occurred. In another 10,000 years the Dog Days will be in mid winter, so problem solved. Even now Dog Days are a hot topic; Florence and the Machine released 'Dog Days are Over' in 2009. Cole Porter had the same message: 'It's Too Darned Hot'.

Creative Community Garden Project



As you walk past Hurst Green Community Centre take a look at what we have been doing recently. Hebe, thyme and violas are blooming by the steps up to the hall, a new border with shrubs and flowers has been created and a long wooden fence is being painted forest green.

We invited 'Men in Sheds' to help 'Mighty Oaks Youth Club' make two nest boxes and two bug boxes which have been painted and put up. Local children and adults made a bug hotel. We hope to attract small birds such as blue tits into the nest boxes and mason bees, lacewings and ladybirds into the bug boxes. There are a lot of weeds to get rid of including bindweed, but we are working on this! Once this is cleared we will plant something more beautiful instead. Over the next couple of months or so we will be working with a professional artist to make a large mosaic panel. Thank you to all the people in Hurst Green who donated to this year's appeal, via the red envelopes and following the church service.

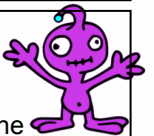
