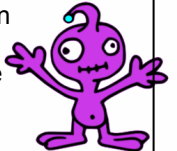
Hurst Green Village Fair

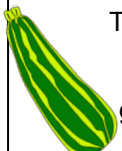

Following the recent celebrations for the Queen's 90th birthday, we are going to run a series of articles in which local residents who are 90 (or older) share their memories with us. The first one is from Vic Farmer who shares his wartime experiences. If you know of someone in Hurst Green who would like to participate, please contact the compiler (details on the bottom of the front page) - we'd love to hear from you.

VIC FARMER



Vic Farmer came to live in the Oxted area in the early 1940s and in 1942, aged 18, he joined the RAF. He had always been interested in flying and when, as a teenager, he spoke to a Battle of Britain pilot, he was determined that he too would fly one day. Unfortunately, sometimes life doesn't turn out the way you plan and Vic was advised that he wasn't suitable to be a pilot, so instead he trained as a navigator.

After initial training, Vic was selected to be part of a six-man crew comprising a pilot, radio operator, air-gunners, bomb aimer and Vic as navigator. Their training continued and this was not without risk as they used all sorts of aircraft, some of which were not in the best condition.

Their pilot, an Australian, however, gave them all cause for concern as they nearly lost their lives on more than one occasion while training. The crew decided they did not want to fly with him any more and so approached the Squadron Commander to request a new pilot. They were accused of being LMF (lacking in moral fibre) but as they were able to point out that they were not refusing to fly, rather refusing to fly with their assigned pilot, their request was eventually met.

Their new pilot was very experienced and quickly gained the respect of the crew. Vic went on to fly a tour of 30 operations including bombing oil installations to cut the Nazi fuel supply, bombing railway transport so that the Nazis were unable to bring reinforcements to the front and targeting factories which were making rockets and aircraft.

Vic went on to become a navigation instructor and was commissioned as an officer in 1944 just before his 21st birthday. When the war ended, he stayed in the RAF until 1946 and then went on to train as a teacher. All of the crew survived and the strong bond that they formed during their training and subsequent operations remained with them for the rest of their lives. Vic is now the sole survivor.

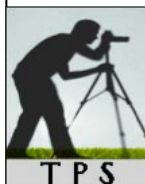
