## Local Plan Proposals

*We know that housing and planning developments are of interest to readers of Hurst Green News, so we contacted the Council and some Councillors for their comments. To date, we have had the one response from Jackie Wren which is published below:*

In May, I was elected to Tandridge Council for the Oxted and Limsfield Residents Group (OLRG) with a large majority. I was elected by residents from across the political spectrum because of widespread concern that the Council's new Local Plan proposals are unjustifiably and unnecessarily putting our green spaces at risk. People are worried about the effects of too much development on our local environment and on our already creaking infrastructure.

The proposals have identified very many open spaces as 'deliverable and developable' including the Council owned Mill Lane and Boulthurst Way recreation grounds and 7 pieces of Green Belt land around Hurst Green. There has already been a huge amount of house building - twice the housing target set down in the current Local Plan. Other districts did not build and so Tandridge has ended up meeting the housing needs of those other areas, but without adding to local jobs or to infrastructure. Now the Council is proposing to carry on building at an even greater rate than before.

OLRG commissioned legal, planning and demographic experts to review the proposals. Our planning consultant visited the Green Belt sites in the Hurst Green area and found that they strongly fulfilled the purposes of the Green Belt and that the assessments had not been properly carried out. The 90 page expert opinion document concluded that the proposals are unsustainable and contrary to the objectives of the Government's National Planning Policy Framework.

In a few weeks the Council is due to publish its Sites Consultation, effectively a consultation on the release of Green Belt sites for development. Residents will have 8 weeks to comment. OLRG will again be taking expert opinion. We are determined to have a Local Plan that complies with national policy. We are determined to stop unjustified and unnecessary development of our green spaces. *Jackie Wren, Tandridge District Councillor for Oxted North and Tandridge*

## CREATIVE COMMUNITY calls out for votes to bag a share of a £12.5 million carrier bag charge fund

They have applied to Tesco for a grant under the Bags of Help initiative which sees grants, all raised from the 5p bag levy, being awarded to environmental and greenspace projects. More than 2,800 groups up and down the country have applied and these have been whittled down to three in each of Tesco's regions.

The good news is that Creative Community has made it through to the shortlist! But we now need your help in voting for us. Voting is open in stores from 31 October to 13 November. You can vote using a token given to you at the checkout in store each time you shop. Our nearest Tesco shops are in Caterham and Redhill.

## VIC FARMER

Following an article in last month's Hurst Green News, Vic Farmer, resident of Hurst Green, tells us how he trained as a navigator in the RAF and served during the Second World War.

After training, he was based in RAF North Killingholme in Lincolnshire. He flew in a Lancaster and each Lancaster was assigned a letter. His plane was labelled with an 'X' and was affectionately called the 'Daily Xpress'.

Flying with the 550 Squadron, Vic explains they survived several close shaves, returning from one raid with dozens of holes in the plane's under-surface. Each operation (and there were 30 in total) was different: weather permitting, flying to different locations, day and night. And, on many occasions, it was the flying skill of the pilot, Flight Lieutenant Rhys 'Skip' Thomas, that ensured they got back safely.

While Vic's crew survived the war, many of his colleagues were not so fortunate. Vic's crew shared a Nissan hut with another crew who they got to know relatively well. He recalls being woken one night by the sound of administrators collecting the kit and personal belongings of the other crew who had been killed, just leaving empty beds. The sight of those empty beds still haunts Vic to this day. After a few days, they were occupied by a new crew.

Vic forged life-long friendships and the affection he holds for the rest of the crew is obvious as he explains that you literally put your life in other people's hands, relying on their skills to get you home safely at the end of each operation. He explains the crew were inseparable – eating, drinking, sleeping as a unit and forging the strong bond required as there was always a very real possibility that they could die together. He tells us that they were very high spirited, often into mischief but always supporting each other, whatever the cost.

Vic is the only one now left and still likes to share his wartime memories with others.
