Local Plan Proposals

Following last month's article on local planning proposals, this important subject continues to be discussed and the position of our Conservative Councillors for Oxted South is as follows:

The government requires Tandridge District Council to produce a new Local Plan as part of its objective to house southern England's growing population. According to the Office of National Statistics, the number of people living in Tandridge is likely to grow from 85,000 to c.100,000 in 20 years, people living much longer being a major factor. Those residents, including nurses, carers and other key workers, will have to live somewhere and we need to plan for that.

Despite these demands, your Conservative led council is determined to preserve the special character of Tandridge by using this Local Plan process to secure improvements to schools, health care and transport links, protect our Green Belt and deliver affordable homes for local people.

The approach taken in formulating the plan is in line with national guidance, the approach taken by other Surrey councils and, despite what Oxted and Limpsfield Residents Group would have you believe, is supported by outside experts and best practice. This is vitally important; if we decided not to follow the national guidelines, the Local Plan would be rejected, as happened in one of our neighbouring districts. Alarming, the rejection of our plan would result in a free-for-all for developers.

Tandridge has not been singled out. The 470 new houses per year, identified as a starting point, (representing a 1.3% annual increase in homes) is similar to that of neighbouring councils (which range from 1.0% to 1.5%). However, the actual *target* for house building that comes out of the Local Plan will be based on our ability to supply sites. This will be heavily influenced by the fact that we are 94% green belt. The number of houses the Planning Inspector will accept as a 20-year target will be based on **evidence**, not as some plan opponents appear to believe, on whether we like it or not.

So when the sites consultation comes out on the 4 November, please don't assume that there is some underhand plan to concrete over the Green Belt. It is the last thing we would choose to do. Instead, please help us convince the inspector that the district cannot accommodate the number of homes needed to house all who would wish to live here.

Finally, despite incorrect scaremongering from some quarters, we can **guarantee** that the Mill Lane playing field in Hurst Green will not be re-developed. Indeed, as this newsletter goes to print a new £20,000 multi-use games area should be in the process of being installed behind the Sports & Social club pavilion, clear evidence of the Council's commitment to this treasured facility.

Lest We Forget - Hurst Green War Memorial

Once again the flowers placed on the War Memorial at the junction of Tanhouse Road and Woodhurst Lane will be replaced by poppies and wreaths taken there following the annual Service of Remembrance at St John's Church. For many years this service was held at the War Memorial, but due to increasing numbers the service now takes place in the church grounds. However, the national 2 minute silence is still observed at both the Memorial and the Church.

The date on which the War Memorial was built is not known but it was funded wholly or partly by a local family living in Woodhurst Lane on grounds provided by the Stone Hall Estate. At that time Tanhouse Road was the main route to Oxted. The Memorial and the surrounding area were maintained over the years by volunteers as it belonged neither to the Church nor the British Legion. In 2011 it was brought to the notice of the Parish Council that water damage was making the names unreadable and as a result the Council had it refurbished and names later known added.

There have been occasional suggestions that the Memorial be moved but these have been ardently opposed as it has become an appreciated Hurst Green land mark and acts as a reminder not only of those who served in the 1914-18 and 1939-45 wars, but also to those still serving today.

Margaret Mummery

As part of our series of talks with local residents, Margaret Mummery who, like the Queen, was 90 this year has been sharing some of her early memories with us.

Margaret was living in Woodford, Essex when war broke out and the family decided to evacuate to Cornwall. However, after about a year, they returned to Woodford where they were caught up in the bombing of nearby London and it became a very regular occurrence to spend lots of time in the bomb shelter. Margaret's cocker spaniel (which, as a child, she'd saved up to buy) could tell the difference between the air raid warning which meant they had to go to the bomb shelter and the all-clear - unlike her grandmother who was hard of hearing!

She left school at the age of 17 and went to work for the Metropolitan Water Board. She worked there for 11 years and was very happy even though she had never wanted to work in an office. When she married, she had to stop work as that was the requirement in those days, something which most of us find hard to imagine now. Outside of work, she was heavily involved with the local Brownies and Guides and taught at Sunday school and these activities played a big role throughout her life.

Her husband worked for Shell and was posted to Venezuela for a year and the whole family (by now, she had two daughters) went with him. Margaret recalls the village in which they were based was fairly primitive with lots of animals running around including goats, pigs, dogs, chickens and donkeys. No-one seemed to own any of these and Margaret used to put out a bucket of water for the animals to drink.

The family moved to the Oxted area in 1961 and have seen many changes over the years. Margaret remembers being able to walk straight from her house on to the Downs, whereas now there are several housing estates and a motorway in between. Her love of animals continues and she now shares her home with a beautiful friendly cat called Lady Penelope.
