The Colour Purple

As I write, it's the season of Lent and as many churches are adorned with it, I've been thinking about the colour purple. Purple has a number of musical and literary associations.

The first that came to mind is of course the film and novel, 'The Colour Purple', by Alice Walker. The story charts the journey of Celie Harris, a young black woman who faces all kinds of problems living in the rural South of America. She struggles against racism and sexism but in time the colour purple is transformed from a colour of pain (bruises) to beauty (in the flowers she begins to notice and the colour she wears at the end).



Then there is the popular poem by Jenny Joseph, 'When I am Old' and the desire of one woman to be freed from the conventions of society to do what she wants, when she wants, and so be truly herself, including wearing purple if she fancies it! Finally, the song and album with the same name 'Purple Rain' by Prince. This too paints a vision of something better. The writer laments a relationship of pain and all it might have been including laughter and joy 'in purple rain'.

Purple, in church, in Lent: the colour of lament and mourning, penitence and kingship and of journey, to the cross and the purple robe of Jesus. Perhaps we might journey with the colour purple this Lent? The sight of a new crocus poking through dark earth or wearing a favourite purple hat or coat that cheers our soul might remind or inspire us of something more. We are always on a journey and wherever we start, as those classic texts and tunes demonstrate, there is always hope and the potential for something new and positive and good to grow out of what has gone before.

At St John's and other local churches we will also journey through Lent with the colour purple to the crucified Christ and recognise the possibility through him of transformation, healing, new life and the discovery of who we really are in Christ. THIS is the Christian hope and promise we celebrate on Easter Day.

And all are welcome: welcome to any of the local services at local churches during Lent, Holy Week and Easter (more details over the page) and welcome, at any time, *even now in this very moment*, into the compassionate and merciful arms of Christ opened for us all on the cross.

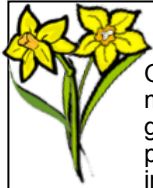

Gardening in the spring

Our February talk at the Club has converted me to use 1¼ plastic cell containers to germinate seeds, which seem to be far more productive than planting a few seeds into four-inch pots.

Also the reusable Rootainers modular system uses deep tapered cells of corrugated plastic that channel roots down avoiding, circling; these are especially good for growing sweet peas. Chitted potatoes should be planted in April and summer flowering bulbs. Lift and divide overgrown climbing perennials; prune bush and climbing roses giving the plants a good rose feed in readiness for sturdy growth. The pelargonium cuttings I took last autumn are putting on a real show of growth, so more frequent watering of house plants is required in readiness for them to be planted out, either directly in beds or patio pots later when any chance of frost has passed.

Wildlife could do with a helping hand especially bees, so bundles of bamboo lengths and chunks of untreated wood could be secured in a quiet, sheltered spot in full sun about a metre from the ground. Nesting birds would welcome any animal hair to line their nests. After grooming your animal pets, place tufts in a nearby bush or hedge and watch the birds fly off with a beak full of warm insulation!

Exhibition of Early 20th Century Prints by Arthur Keen 5 - 7 April 2017

The Limsfield Decorative & Fine Arts Society (LDFAS) and Oxted & District History Society are jointly organising an Exhibition of 60 early 20th century prints at the Millennium Rooms next to St Peter's Church, Limsfield on 5 - 7 April between 10am and 5pm.

Arthur Keen (1861-1938) FRIB, was an architect and accomplished draughtsman who lived in Station Road East and subsequently in Uvedale Road. He designed the Oxted & Limsfield War Memorial Hospital and Limsfield Village Hall. An amateur archaeologist and historian, he spent the last 7 years of his life drawing the beautiful old buildings in and around Oxted & Limsfield. The Exhibition includes 60 of his best works. The prints have been kindly loaned by Stephen Jones and prepared for the Exhibition by Mrs Hank Arnold and Chris Pendred.

LDFAS meets monthly for an illustrated talk on an arts subject and arranges visits to historic houses, gardens, galleries and museums and an annual 6 day tour in the UK or in Europe.
