WELCOME & INTRODUCTION

On this second Sunday of Epiphany we rejoice that God has revealed himself in Jesus, who calls us to follow him. May we be open to his invitation and always be ready to respond to his call.

OPENING PRAYER

Faithful God, whose word is life,

CONFESSION

Christ has brought us out of darkness to live in his marvellous light. As we come before God now, we recognise that we do not always reflect his glorious light.

We call to mind the things for which we want to say sorry to God.

Let us seek his forgiveness and healing, confident that he understands our weaknesses and will restore and strengthen us. We confess our sins in penitence and faith.

God our Father, we come to you in sorrow for our sins. For turning away from you, and ignoring your will for our lives; Father, forgive us.
For behaving just as we wish, without thinking of you; Father, forgive us.
For failing you by what we do, and think and say; Father, forgive us.
For letting ourselves be drawn away from you by temptations in the world about us; Father, forgive us.
For living as if we were ashamed to belong to your Son; Father, forgive us, save us and help us.

We hear God's words of absolution and forgiveness

May God who loved the world so much
that he sent his Son to be our Saviour
forgive *us our* sins
and make *us* holy to serve him in the world,
through Jesus Christ our Lord.
