REVD MARK ANDERSON: Mark preached for the last time at St John's at the 9.45am service on 12 December 2021. After 4½ years as the Assistant Curate in the Oxted Team, Mark is moving on to begin his new appointment as Rector in the Benefice of Sherfield on Loddon and Stratfield Saye with Hartley Wespall with Stratfield Turgis and Bramley. These are four parishes just north of Basingstoke in the Diocese of Winchester. During his time here Mark has led Café Church at St John's and also Youth Work in the York Rooms. He and his family will be moving house just before Christmas to begin in mid January. We wish him well!

CARE4CALAIS COLLECTION: Following the dreadful news that a number of refugees lost their lives in the Channel after their dinghy capsized, a bucket collection was held at St John's after the 8.30 and 9.45am services on Advent Sunday, 28 November. The £250 raised was sent to Care4Calais who provide emergency aid to refugees in Calais and areas affected by the European migrant crisis.

ECO CHURCH FOR 2022: The Eco Church Group met on 8 December and ideas for environmental and ecological actions were discussed. Areas being considered are worship, buildings, community and lifestyles, land and global engagement. Initial thoughts will be presented to the wider congregation in early 2022, to garner interest and preferences for action. Watch this space....

CRISIS: You may have read in the introduction overleaf that there was no certainty that the service of Nine Lessons and Carols on 19 December would actually go ahead. Fortunately it did and was a lovely occasion. Afterwards a magnificent £415 was raised for Crisis, the national charity that provides shelter, hot meals and companionship for the homeless, especially over the Christmas period but also throughout the year.

Tentative discussions are underway for the next event - possibly a performance at St John's of The Crucifixion by Stainer before Easter.
