Not really a Jubilee

I recently watched the Jubilee with my grandson and niece. They were very interested by the spectacle of what they were watching although both were perplexed by the pomp and ceremony of what was going on.

Both were keen to ask what a Jubilee was and both were very dissatisfied with my rather short answer of, "a kind of party celebrating the Queen's reign". This led to a longer series of questions on why should we celebrate the Queen's reign? Why did the party cost more than twenty-eight million pounds to put on? Etc, etc. Young teenagers do ask very challenging and annoying questions at times. They also seem to never be particularly satisfied with any answers!!

However, their questions did remind me of a definition of what Jubilee meant; "a year of emancipation and restoration, kept every seven years and forty-nine years in ancient Jewish society."

I was reminded that as splendid and extravagant as the Queen's Jubilee celebrations were, they would have suffered in comparison to the Jubilee celebrations in ancient Jewish society. These celebrations had a real significance beyond just being a party. As in the year of Jubilee every seven years slaves and prisoners would be freed, debts would be forgiven, and the mercies of God would be particularly manifest. The Jubilee year celebrated every forty-nine years, that is seven times seven normal Jubilee years, had special significance when all land returned to the original owners. For the ancient Jews, Jubilee was all about freedom, restoration and receiving God's rich blessings.

When I shared this explanation of Jubilee with my grandson and niece, they both seemed to find it a more satisfying and understandable explanation than my previous feeble attempts to explain what Jubilee meant.

In 2000 the Jubilee campaign was started which aimed to wipe out the debt of "third world countries" held by "first world" countries. To date the debt of 36 nations to the International Monetary Fund and the World Bank has been wiped out, with the proceeds going to fight poverty in these nations. Despite this important step, the global debt crisis continues to cripple poor countries. Countries in Africa, Asia, the Pacific, Latin America and the Caribbean owe over \$6 trillion. The debt in the poorest countries that received debt relief is growing rapidly again due to the financial crises started in the "first world". As much I enjoyed the Queen's Jubilee I look forward to the year of Jubilee for these indebted countries when they will know freedom and restoration. Now that is a Jubilee I will really celebrate.

East Surrey Walkers (ESW) News

ESW trust that those of you who have joined The Queen's Platinum Jubilee events have enjoyed the celebrations. The ESW summer walks programme will have been published by the time you read this.

The most famous part of the battle of Balaclava, the Charge of the Light Brigade, took place in October 1854. What is the local connection?

There is much debate on what happened. However, a combination of light dragoons and hussars were instructed by Lord Raglan to charge the Russians with a view to recapture artillery. It appears that the wrong emplacements were attacked in the charge. The unsupported Light Brigade came under heavy fire but never the less actually reached the Russian guns.

In danger of being cut off they were forced to retreat. More than 600 men took part in the charge - about 110 were killed, 57 taken prisoner and 465 returned to British lines,134 of them wounded. However, fewer than half of the horses remained alive and unhurt. As a fighting force, the Light Brigade had effectively ceased to exist.

Major John Berryman took part in the charge; his horse was shot from under him though he was uninjured. While making his way to safety he came across Captain Webb who was injured. Webb instructed Berryman to get to safety and leave him. Berryman declined, remained with Webb and having been joined by another officer they evacuated Webb to safety. Throughout they were under heavy shot and artillery fire. Major Berryman was awarded the Victoria Cross for his valour. What of the local connection? Major Berryman died in June 1896 and is buried in St Agatha's Churchyard, Woldingham.

ESW walks are conducted at a comfortable walking pace and you will not be expected to "charge" (nor do we render any financial charge for our walks). You are invited to join members for a taster walk. Please check the programme for a walk that will suit you. ESW wish you happy walking. Stephen Hanks
