Time to say Good-bye

I was 20 when the National Lottery started. I didn't have a job and in those early weeks, once or twice, I bought a ticket. As the Saturday evening drew closer and closer, I felt more and more sick - I was terrified I might actually win! I was really scared winning may not actually be a good thing and somehow 'change me'. Now I'm not passing judgement on anybody who enters the lottery – someone must win each week and to win the jackpot and be relieved of money worries overnight, an increasing problem for so many of us, would be incredible...



What I am highlighting is my attitude to change. Sometimes change is welcome, but is still hard. Sometimes it is unwanted but must be endured. Most of us struggle with it and I'm highlighting it now because things are about to change for my family and for St John's because I have a new role, in North Yorkshire (mainly the Dales) as the new Bishop of Ripon which is exciting and daunting in equal measure!

But as I've pondered 'change' I have wondered why we worry so much. We actually live with 'constant change' (there's a contradiction in terms). Spring and the cycle of the seasons remind us that change is always with us. I helped with my daughter's school disco recently and marvelled at how the children she went to pre-school with when we first moved here are now on the cusp of secondary school, all looking really 'cool' and grooving away. And then there is the change of our own bodies, the aging process from which none of us can escape!

In the bible there is a wonderful passage appreciated by many both of and beyond the Christian Faith. It's in Ecclesiastes 3 and starts '*There is a time for everything...*' and so perhaps we might begin to trust that something bigger than us is holding all time. The writer continues:

"God has made everything beautiful in its time. He has also set eternity in the human heart... I know that everything God does will endure forever; nothing can be added to it and nothing taken from it."

So, I have decided to focus not on change, but on time. Even when times change, what has gone before can never be un-done, good or bad. But God holds it all, heals and redeems and gives us hope.

I am incredibly sad to leave all you wonderful parishioners, exciting initiatives and great hopes and plans for the future. And yes, St John's will have to face a time of waiting for a new parish priest. But what has gone before and what lies ahead we must leave with all our worries, with God. So inviting you to do the same, I offer it all To God in these words of St Augustine of Hippo:

"Give the past to the mercy of God, the present to the grace of God and the future to the providence of God. Amen."

Thank you for a wonderful 9 and a half years as your parish priest here in Hurst Green. And did you know that 'Goodbye' has evolved from the words 'God Bless You?' So goodbye and God Bless you all – with my love and prayers as ever,

Pollards Oak Redevelopment: Courtyard Project



As part of an initiative to keep our community healthy and vibrant, it was proposed to install a "courtyard" in front of the shops in Pollards Oak Road, where local people could sit and chat within a pleasant environment of plants and shrubs. This would include seats, picnic benches and the area would have a surrounding low level wooden fence. There may also be features which local schools could help make. We're hoping that the vegetation could be tended by local volunteers.

A team of HG residents, a local GP, a health manager, a local care worker and councillors has been in place for a few months to speak with local residents and shops, to produce a draft plan of what the area might look like. What we'd like to do now is get the views and ideas of local residents and ask them to comment on our draft plan, before we confirm the layout and seek tenders from local contractors to construct it.

To do this, we've planned a drop-in for local residents, and we would love to see as many of you there as possible.
