## October 2023

**Harvest, Autumn and seasons of fruitfulness have crept up on us again.** Paul Laurence Dunbar born Ohio 1872 wrote a much-loved October poem:

*'October is the treasurer of the year,  
And all the months pay bounty to her store;  
The fields and orchards still their tribute bear,  
And fill her brimming coffers more and more.'*

In the years following his death aged just 33, Dunbar's standing as the foremost Black American poet seemed assured. He writes of living Autumn life joyously, caring not when 'Frost stalks o'er her way and turns her auburn locks to grey.'

I wonder as I write what sort of Autumn we will have after our roasting days in early September.

This year has seen many examples of the disaster of Climate Change, fires in Hawaii, Canada and Europe, hurricanes/floods in US, China, Europe, India. Penguin colonies have been lost, vast swathes of Antarctic ice melted, leaving young chicks to drown because their downy feathers are not yet waterproof.

St. John's Hurst Green might currently have lost our vicar to the Bishopric of Ripon and our Curate to be Vicar of Christ Church West Wimbledon, but we have not given up! We are keen to work with you, our Community to play our part, to challenge and change. A talk by A Rocha (a global family of conservation organisations working together to live out God's calling to care for creation and equip others to do likewise) will take place in the main church building at 7pm on Monday 16 October. Karen Park is an Authorised Lay Minister and Eco Church Champion in Horsham with great experience in motivating us to play our part. She will speak on "Churches and Communities Tackling Climate Change Together". There will be time to ask questions with refreshments on completion to give everyone a chance to network and chat.

*'Do you feel the world is broken – we do.'* runs a song by Andrew Peterson that we sing occasionally at Café Church. What can we do? How can we tackle this issue? Andrew sings - 'Do you know that all the dark won't stop the light from getting through'. Come and listen, come and see what steps we can make as a Community. Let's see the light of God shine through and live our lives out joyously as Dunbar writes. *Wendy Hewitt, Reader, St John's Church*

Founded in 2011, The Split Squad is a true rock 'n' roll supergroup. As well as Burke, they boast guitarist Kurt Bloch (Filthy Friends, The Young Fresh Fellows); Keith Streng (The Fleshtones); Michael Giblin (Parallax Project); and Josh Kantor, who during the summer months plays the organ at world famous baseball ground Fenway Park, home of the Boston Red Sox.
