**It is in the eye of the beholder!** Obi-Wan Kenobi once advised Luke Skywalker to not trust his eyes, because *“your eyes can deceive you.”* Most of us can recall an instance from our own non-Jedi lives when these words rang true. How many of us have looked at the clouds and seen dragons, sailing ships or even faces of loved ones there? This phenomenon, called motivated perception, has been explored in psychological research for decades. Indeed, the world as we conceive it in our awareness is not exactly an accurate representation of what it truly is. Our perception is often biased, selective, and malleable. I have discovered this over the last year in my own life.

Many people have mentioned the progress of the new church building currently going up on the Green. I have found it strange that there appear to be wildly differing views on how the building process is going. Some remark how quickly the new church has “sprung up”. Others will, just as sincerely, remark on how slowly the whole thing is going. Same building but very different views.



This divergence of opinion on the speed of construction remarkably mirrors the divergence of opinions about the value of the new church. I have had some people liken the knocking down of the existing Manse and church to an act of egotistical vandalism; in other words it is a vanity project. A point made with great vigour and no little emotion. Others have remarked on how marvelous it is to see the new church rise as a sign of hope, as a new community resource, as a wonderful addition to Hurst Green. Same building but very different views on its value.

I think this quote by Miguel Ruiz explains why there is such a divergence of opinion about the value of the new church building; *“We only see what we want to see and hear what we want to hear. We don’t perceive things the way they are. We have the habit of dreaming with no basis in reality. We literally dream things up in our imaginations. Because we don’t understand something, we make an assumption about the meaning, and when the truth comes out, the bubble of our dream pops and we find out it was not what we thought it was at all.”*

Whatever your stance on the construction or the purpose of the building I would urge you to consider this old proverb, *“The proof of the pudding is in the eating.”* This expression means that the value of anything is best appreciated by experiencing.

Therefore, I cordially invite you to come along in late December of this year as the building is officially opened, God willing, and find out for yourself what the value of the new church building is.

In the meantime, I leave you with the words that all at Hurst Green Evangelical Church felt as we, with great trepidation, started considering the redevelopment of the church site three years ago;

**Isaiah 43: 18 – 19**

*“Forget the former things;  
do not dwell on the past.*

*See, I am doing a new thing!*

*Now it springs up; do you not perceive it?*

*I am making a way in the wilderness  
and streams in the wasteland.”*

## Refugee Tales

has grown out of the work of Gatwick Detainees Welfare Group to raise awareness of immigration detention and the fact that people are held indefinitely i.e. there is no time limit on detention. This has very serious effects on the mental health of people many of whom have already suffered considerable trauma.

Refugee Tales is an annual 4 day walk in solidarity with refugees, asylum seekers and people who have experienced immigration detention. Each day 120 people walk, and taking Chaucer's great poem of journeying as a model, established writers and people with lived experience of detention, share tales at evening events and listen to music from around the world.

This year the walk is from Edenbridge to Westminster and the first day, 6th July, is from Edenbridge to Oxted with the evening event at Oxted United Reformed Church. The evening event is open to the public. To obtain tickets go to [www.refugeetales.org](http://www.refugeetales.org) and click on 'Walk of 24'. Scroll down to Evening Events where you can see the names of the people taking part and book tickets.

Some of the Tales told in the evenings have been written collaboratively with eminent authors such as the 2021 Nobel Laureate in Literature, Abdulrazak Gurnah, Ali Smith, Patrick Gale, Kamila Shamsie and Bernardine Evaristo with the authors reading them at the evening events. Others are first-hand accounts told directly by the people who experienced them.

Four editions of Tales have been published and over 20,000 copies sold. They are now set texts in 50 universities in this country and abroad. The books will be on sale on 6th July.

## 100 years of the The Barn Theatre

On May 25th 1923, the Surrey Mirror announced some exciting news to local residents:

*"It is proposed to erect a public hall for the service of Oxted and Limpsfield and surrounding parishes, to be known as the Barn Theatre."*

The theatre was designed by Matthews Ridley, a firm of architects and within a year was built at a cost of £3,742 by local contractor James Boodle. On May 22nd 1924 it was opened by the playwright Mr. Harley Granville Barker of the British Drama League.

It was decided that the best way to raise the money needed was to form a limited liability public company with a capital of £4,000. The Oxted and Limpsfield Barn Theatre Company Ltd., chaired by Sir Ernest J. P. Benn, Bart. (grandfather of Tony Benn) was founded and the shares were offered to the residents of the district. The site in Blue House Lane had already been chosen due to it being about equidistant from the centre of the parishes of Oxted and Limpsfield. It was near to the railway station and close to the "omnibus" route and was subsequently purchased from the then 'Squire', Hoskins Master in October 1923 for the sum of £275. The old saw mill barn which stood at the bottom of Limpsfield village had been purchased from Mr. Lewis G. Fry at a cost of £75 and was to be used as the main structure for the building.

To celebrate its Centenary year, throughout May and June, The Barn Theatre have lots of events and shows to celebrate.
