have fun. For one day only, open grassy fields are transformed into a hubbub of activity as stalls are set up to sell homemade food, delicious cakes, beautiful gifts, play traditional games and raise money for local causes.

This is my first summer in Hurst Green, so I asked Amanda, who heads up the organising team for the Hurst Green village fair, to tell me more about it.

Amanda said: "The fair has been running for around 45 years, so probably since 1979 and has always been held on the green next to Aggie's hall. It started as a church initiative to help bring the community together and we now have churches, schools, local clubs and groups attending every year."

Amanda has been going to the fair since 2007 when she moved to Hurst Green. In 2018, Amanda was asked to help by setting up in the morning and the next year Amanda was asked to help a little more and stayed all day. From that point Amanda became involved in the planning of the fair, together with a small committee which is made up of local people; Geoff Booth, Mark Thompson, Sarah Randall and Catriona Aleppo (who runs the Facebook page) along with various family members. When asked what Amanda liked best about the fair she said: "Hurst Green Village Fair is a fun event, it seems a fitting thing to do at the end of summer. It's great to see local talented people selling their wares and local groups showing us their talents creatively, musically and artistically."

Thank you Amanda and to everyone involved in the fair. The day is an amalgamation of enterprise, charity and community spirit. It's a fun way to celebrate and for all generations to spend a few hours together, enjoying a tradition preserved over centuries. I'm really looking forward to the day and hope to see you all there.

Join your local walking group and keep fit this Autumn

Formed in 1983, East Surrey Walkers is your local Ramblers group, with Around 450 members. We mainly walk in East Surrey, but do occasionally stray into Kent and Sussex. If you enjoy walking and would like to meet new people, come along and join us on a walk. You don't have to be a member to join in for the first three walks, but after that, we ask that you join.

- currently £41 a year or £55 for joint membership.

We have 3 or more walks most weeks, with a range of distances and grades from easy ambles of about 3 miles through to Fast Fitness Workout Walks which are generally 4 miles, completed in an hour. We also have leisurely walks of around 5-6 miles and other longer walks, up to about 12 miles. We are active in protecting and improving the local rights of way network with members volunteering to inspect paths, and undertaking individual maintenance tasks as well as our monthly work party (Ken's Krew) who undertake tasks such as replacing stiles with kissing gates.

North Downs Archery Club meet every

Sunday from 9.30am at Matchpoint Lifeline Fitness Centre in Hurst Green, Oxted. In September they will be running beginners' courses on 8th, 15th and 22nd September 2024.



The course is run over three consecutive Sunday mornings. The sessions run from 09:30am to 12.30pm (the usual club meeting time) and are held in the field adjoining Matchpoint Lifeline Fitness Centre in Hurst Green. The cost of the course is £65. Juniors (11-17yrs) must be accompanied at all times by a parent or responsible adult (both during the course and attending the club if they join). There is a combined discount of £20 for a junior and adult signing up for the course together. We highly recommend that a parent or guardian does the beginners' course alongside a junior, particularly since they have to be in attendance anyway. Often we have had parents wishing they had signed up, who then have had to wait 6 months until the next course. Each beginner receives a copy of Archery GB's book "The Archery for Beginners Guidebook". The sessions also include Safety Procedures and Rules of Shooting, demonstrations of Freestyle and Barebow Shooting, and information on how to continue enjoying archery at club level.

The course is limited to a maximum of 12 people; spaces will be allocated on a first-come, first-served basis. To enrol on the course, send an email to northdac@gmail.com for an application form.
