MEMORIES

When I was a small child, there was a song on the radio by Frank Ifield, called 'I remember you-ooooo / You're the one who made my dreams come true / A few wishes ago... '

As I grow older, I seem to recall many things from my childhood, which pop into my head unbidden; the green

budgie that would sit on the wheel of the sewing machine as my mother made clothes for my dolls out of fabric scraps; family holidays in a caravan at Sandy Bay in Devon, all squashed into my brother's Austin A35, including the dog!; playing ball with my sister in the road {not many cars then...}. Yet I cannot remember someone's name five minutes after we have met!

Musicians find memorising their pieces very helpful in producing a spontaneous and expressive performance, although many, including me, prefer to play from a score to save embarrassing memory slips. Often our memory is prompted by a piece of music, reminding us of a person or place we have loved in the past, the moment stored in our memory bank, and the music prompting a fleeting snapshot of a special occasion. Aromas can have the same effect, taking us back to a school canteen, a walk in the park, our mother's scent.

Many memories are celebrated with the planting of a shrub or tree, and no matter how that plant grows, we cherish it because of the person it calls to mind. I have far too many Japanese anemones in my garden, but I am loath to pull them up because they came from a cutting from my mum's garden after she died, and to discard them would be like discarding a bit of her.

The gradual decline or sudden loss of memory is devastating to those who witness it in their family members. Charles Dickens wrote, 'I verily believe that her not remembering and not minding in the least, made me cry again, inwardly – and that is the

sharpest crying of all.' He also wrote in David Copperfield, 'It's in vain...to recall the past, unless it works some influence upon the present.', which is why, at this time of the year our thoughts turn to the act of Remembrance. At the 11th hour on the 11th day of the 11th month, we stop and remember all those who gave their lives to save their fellow countrymen from oppression, the red poppies we wear signifying their blood shed on the battlefields. We mark this in the hope that the memory of those awful days will be so etched upon our collective lives that nothing like it will ever happen again.

In the Bible, we read that Jesus broke bread and drank wine with his disciples, saying, 'Take, eat. This is my body which is given for you. Do this in remembrance of me.' {Luke 22.19} We use these words in the Eucharistic prayer when we take communion, to remember that Christ died on the cross to give us eternal life. Many will have come to St

Johns church for the All-Souls service to think about family and friends. May your memories be happy and bring you joy and peace as you remember those you love but see no more. *Hilary Dilnot, Musical Director, St John's Church*

roundabout so that less abled children can enjoy using it as well as a DDA compliant jumper square (ground level trampoline) which many children have requested over the last few months. A DDA compliant swing with a harness and 3 learning boards that children can enjoy using ranging from one that plays different musical notes to maze style puzzles will also be installed. Over the Winter months the ground often gets muddy and soggy so specialised rubber flooring will also be used around this equipment to stop this and soften falls. There are currently picnic benches inside of the play area but these will be moved to outside the playground to give more space.

The speaker has spent six years studying and attributing it, now featured in press around the world. Featuring five royal arms, six single roses, and deeply esoteric symbols of fertility, it turns out to be covered in medieval paintwork, and its proportions respect the mural of the lost Painted Chamber of royal Westminster Palace abandoned in 1512. Scientific analyses, documentation and art history agree to demonstrate it is an astonishing national treasure: the marriage bed of Henry VII and Elizabeth of York, made by 18 January 1486.
