#### February - The Month of Waiting

February is the shortest month in the calendar year but for me, and many others, February feels like a very long month - a month of waiting. February reminds us that times of stillness are important. February is the steppingstone between winter and spring and just as nature goes into hibernation and waits in slumber, we too can use



this time to step back and consider the changes we would like to make and see in our lives. How often have you thought that time was going too fast and life needed to slow down? It is the gentle persuasion of February that asks us to go with the flow and allow life to unravel in its own time. We could use this month as inspiration to relax and enjoy the moment instead of rushing and marking everything as urgent.

In February it is also the beginning of the Lenten season which too carries with it the theme of waiting and perseverance. Lent begins each year on Ash Wednesday, 46 days (40 days plus Sundays) before Easter Sunday. This year, Lent will begin on Wednesday, March 5<sup>th</sup> and finishes on Holy Saturday, before Easter Sunday. The word "Lent" comes from the word "lecten" which means "spring" and refers to the lengthening of days.

Lent is an important part of the Christian calendar. It is a season of contemplation and preparation for Easter. During Lent people usually give something up like chocolate, alcohol or another habit as they follow the example of Jesus who fasted in the wilderness.

February allows us to reflect on our lives and say goodbye to any unwanted rituals or behaviours. You could call it an early spring clean as you get things in order, both internally and externally. It can also be considered as an opportunity to 'take up' something instead.

In February the amount of daylight hours increases and as the days begin to get longer and brighter, it can also represent the amount of light in our lives that is given to us through Jesus. Jesus said, "I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will not walk in darkness and will have the light of life" (John 8:12).

Let this month be fuelled with growth, calmness, and love. I hope that you emerge from these colder months rejuvenated and bursting with optimism.

#### Frogs and toads on the move

It's the time of year when the thoughts of a young toad, or frog, turn to love. But the quest for love is fraught with danger, because of the traffic on our roads.

Frogs and toads instinctively head back each year to the pond where they were bred, making their way from whichever garden they call home. They will make their move when the weather conditions are favourable, usually from early February onwards. As they are cold-blooded, they won't venture out if the temperature (taking into account any windchill) is less than about 5 degrees C. A misty and murky, mild evening is ideal for them.

We have 'Beware of the Toad' signs installed at three different points which are all about 100 metres from the T-junction between Church Way and Oast Road, and they will be uncovered from the beginning of February. These are the stretches of road where you are likely to come across the amphibians as they slowly make their way, up until about the beginning of April. Please, if you can, slow down as you drive there if it's between dusk and about 10pm during the migrating season.

We have a Toad Patrol, of all ages, to help the frogs and toads on their journey, and if you do

drive slowly this will be safer for us

Volunteers for the Toad Patrol are always most welcome. You just need a torch, a



clean bucket and some (unpowdered) plastic or rubber gloves. Please contact me if you're interested. Many thanks, Adrian 07974 171977.
