## Did we miss something this Christmas?

There was a familiar pattern as Christmas approached.  
We became busy.  
We organised.  
We planned.  
We poured time and energy into making sure that Christmas would be good — not just for ourselves, but for those we love. We wanted the meals to be right, the gifts to be thoughtful, the moments to be memorable.

And yet, now that Christmas has come and gone, as the house grows quieter and ordinary life begins to return, there is a small and unsettling question that lingers. Despite all our effort, did we miss something important this Christmas? In all our determination to enjoy Christmas, it is possible to lose sight of why Christmas exists at all.

The gifts under the tree are never the point in themselves. They are signs. Reminders. Echoes of something far greater. At its heart, Christmas is about God's extraordinary gift to us - His very own Son, Jesus Christ. Christmas is, first and foremost, the story of God's love given freely, generously, and humbly. When that is forgotten, something essential is lost, and no amount of celebration can quite replace it.

And this matters not only for how we feel, but for how we live.

Five years ago, around 30 families in Hurst Green faced Christmas without the things many of us quietly assume will be there. No gifts. No decorations. No festive meal. This year, that number rose to around 90 families and probably more who were waiting for support so that they might have something of what we all take for granted.

In a place marked by relative prosperity and material abundance, we live very close to real need. Often unnoticed. Often unseen. We share streets and shops and schools with people carrying heavy burdens, struggling to provide what others take for granted. Christmas invites us to notice them. It invites us to allow the love we celebrate at Christmas to shape the way we respond. If we wish to avoid that empty feeling when Christmas fades, perhaps the answer is love expressed in action.

This New Year, consider contacting the Tandridge Family Centre on 01883 723496. Ask what you might be able to give from what you have. Food. Time. Resources. Compassion — all of it matters.

And we are left with words that speak quietly, but firmly, to people like us:

*"If anyone has material possessions and sees a brother or sister in need but has no pity on them, how can the love of God be in that person? Dear children, let us not love with words or speech but with actions and in truth." (1 John 3:17-18)*

Christmas begins with God's gift to us. It is rediscovered when that gift is shared.

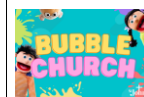

## How to recycle your Christmas tree

If you're a Green Waste Club Member with a real Christmas tree you need to throw away, you can cut up your tree (maximum tree trunk 10cm diameter) and put it in your brown wheeled bin. Please make sure the lid is closed. If you're not a Green Waste Club member, please take it to the community recycling centres at Bond Road, Warlingham or Chaldon Road, Caterham. You can also cut it up and put it in your home compost bin. Please don't attempt to recycle wreaths or trees that have been sprayed, painted, or covered in wire you can't remove.

## Quick and simple tool that helps residents recycle more



Shredded paper, plastic plant pots, asbestos  
and plastic bags are among the most  
searched for items on the Council's website.

The easy to use search, What do I do with?  
shows how to recycle or safely dispose of  
over 400 everyday items - from flip flops and  
walking aids to hangers and paint brushes.  
It also includes information about kerbside  
collections for batteries, vapes, small electrical  
items and textiles, as well as local recycling  
centres and other disposal options.

Top searches in the district and what to do:

- Shredded paper: Home compost or put in your blue recycling bin.
- Plastic plant pots: Recycle at your local community recycling centre (CRC).
- Asbestos: Epsom CRC - please call ahead.
- Plastic bags: Supermarket soft plastic bins or in your blue recycling bin.

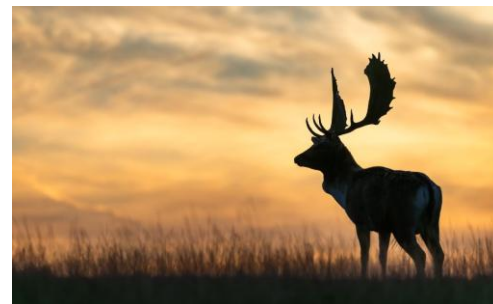
## Fresh Focus for the New Year – a great time for photography
